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
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Comparison of Senior and Deputy Senior Executive Salaries By Venue Type

Senior executives at convention centers and performing arts centers are more highly compensated than those at arenas. Deputy senior executives enjoy higher salaries at convention centers.

Although the base sizes are small for female senior executives (7-19), it appears that they receive slightly higher salaries than men at arenas and performing arts centers, and lower salaries at convention centers.

Since IAVM is an international association, all salary data includes international convention centers. Pages 32-36 contain salary statistics which are limited to the U.S. and Canada.

BACKGROUND

Salary data continues to be the most requested information from IAVM. The IAVM Research Committee opted to create a simple salary survey that only included salary data for full-time staff in the top three levels of a venue. Fringe benefits and perks were not included in this version.



The Report contains the following 2014 salary statistics:

- Average
- Minimum
- 25th percentile
- Median
- 75th percentile
- Maximum
- Number of responses included in the calculation

The Report also includes average salary data from prior years, so that year to year differences can be examined.

86 convention centers, of which 9 are outside the United States, completed the survey. For countries outside of the United States, the financial data was converted to U.S. Dollars and included in the results. For venue managers interested only in U.S./Canadian data, the average salaries can be found at page 33-36 of this report.

METHODOLOGY

Using an internet-based platform provided by PeerFocus, the IAVM 2014 Salary Survey was conducted from January 7th through February 27th, 2014 with 1,082 IAVM member venues.

A total of 255 completed surveys were obtained (86 convention centers, 94 arenas, 15 stadiums and 60 performing arts centers) for a response rate of 24%.

The survey results are examined by several groupings, in order to make this report more meaningful to you. The number of convention centers included in each group is shown below.

The data does not take into account number of years of experience, education or geographic location. Due to situations where the cost of living is higher than other locations within an area, such as New York City or San Diego, the use of geographic location was excluded.

All data reflects the information provided by participants. When data appeared to be contradictory or unlikely, the accuracy was verified with the reporting organization. Outliers and data that could not be confirmed were removed.

The data collection and calculation process was a very extensive multi-step process. In the initial data collection process, significant effort was made to ensure that obvious errors or missing responses in the data were followed up and corrected. Averages and standard deviations were calculated and responses that did not fall within 2 standard deviations of the average were excluded. (Standard deviation is a statistical tool used to measure variability or spread of a sampling of data. In an analysis of collected data, there can be concern about the validity of survey conclusions should there be certain data that are dramatically different than all of the other collected data. A statistical rule-of-thumb for the type of data collected is that approximately 95% of the data falls within two standard deviations of the calculated average.)

No calculations are included when there were less than four responses. As with any type of benchmarking, this is provided as a guideline and you are encouraged to use your discretion and other sources in conjunction with the data herein.

ANALYTICAL NOTE AND JOB TITLES INCLUDED IN THE SURVEY

On all tables included in this report:

- Data is not shown when base sizes are 3 or less.
- Percentage totals may not add to 100% due to rounding.

The 32 job titles covered in this survey, along with further description provided to respondents, are shown below but report data is included for only those job titles pertinent to convention centers.

01. Senior Executive

Responsibility: Overall management of the organization

Typically reports to outside oversight such as corp. management, Board of Directors/Trustees, government dept. head, etc.

Example Titles: President, CEO, GM, Executive Director, Managing Director, etc.

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

02. Deputy Senior Executive

Responsibility: Daily overall operation of the venue and/or programming.

Typically reports to (01) or the same outside authority as the Senior Executive reports to.

Example Titles: COO, GM or Assistant GM, Assistant Director, Assistant Executive Director, Producing Director

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

03. Vice President, Operations/Director of Operations

Responsibility: Oversight of all venue operations, including facility maintenance and management, construction and real property operations. May include patron services, executive oversight of operations, food and beverage services, production services and facility renovations.

Typically reports to: (01) or (02).

04. Chief Financial Officer

Responsibility: Overall oversight of financial operations

Typically reports to (01), (02) or Board of Directors.

Example Titles: CFO, Vice President of Finance, Director of Finance, Comptroller, etc.

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

05. Director of Development/Fundraising/Sponsorship

Responsibility: Raising the contributed revenue budget goal. Oversees capital and endowment campaigns and supervises fundraising staff. Typically reports to: (01) or (02).

06. Director of Programming/Director of Entertainment/Programming Manager

Responsibility: Selects and contracts for programming on which the venue takes an "at risk" position (as opposed to programming produced or presented by rental clients or resident tenants.)

Typically reports to (01), (02) or (03).

07. Director of Event Logistics/Client Services/Production

Responsibility: Overall oversight of staff planning and coordinating event logistics, including possibly oversight of stage/production operations, for outside client events and events produced by the organization. Doesn't typically include patron or guest services.

Typically reports to (01), (02) or (03).

Example titles: Dir. of Events, Dir. of Client Services, Dir. of Production, Dir. Of Convention Services, Production Manager, etc.

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

08. Director of Guest Services

Responsibility: Oversight of all procedures and programs that improve guest satisfaction within a venue. Daily oversight of all public areas and operations of a performing arts center. Could oversee merchandising, food and beverage, A.D.A. compliance services or other patron amenities. Insures quality experience for patrons. Does not typically include client/tenant services.

Typically reports to (01), (02) or (03).

Example titles: Patron Services Director or Manager, Guest Relations Director or Manager, Front of House Manager, Customer Service Manager, etc.

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

09. Vice President, Human Resources/Director of Human Resources

Responsibility: Overall oversight of human resources and capital

Typically reports to (01), (02) or (04).

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

10. Vice President/Director of Sales & Marketing

If the roles of Sales and Marketing are separated for your organization at this level, report separately in (11) and/or (12).

Responsibility: Management of all sales and marketing functions. May include PR, event/promoter local marketing, and/or community outreach responsibilities in addition to marketing the venue's events and facilities, to include productions presented by the venue (as opposed to rental events and/or marketing specifically for the venue).

Do not report on individual program managers, such as regional sales managers or group sales managers, etc.

11. Vice President/Director of Sales

If the roles of Sales and Marketing are combined for your organization at this level, only report in (10).

Responsibility: Management of venue and facility sales functions and not marketing.

Do not report on individual program managers, such as regional sales managers or group sales managers, etc.

12. Vice President/Director of Marketing and Public Relations

If the roles of Sales and Marketing are combined for your organization at this level, only report in (10).

Responsibility: Management of venue and facility marketing functions and not sales. May include PR, event/promoter local marketing, and/or community outreach responsibilities in addition to marketing the venue.

Do not report on individual program managers, such as regional marketing managers or group marketing managers, etc.

13. Vice President, Public Relations/Director of Public Relations/Director of Communications

Responsibility: Overall oversight of public relations and corporate communications. Can include oversight of social media strategy, also government relations/public affairs. Typically reports to (01), (02) or (10)

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

14. Chief Technology Officer/Information Officer

Responsibility: Overall oversight of technology operations

Example Titles: CTO, Director of Information Management, Director of IT, Director of Computer Systems, IT Manager, Systems Manager

Typically reports to (01), (02), (03) or (04).

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

15. Controller/Accounting Manager

Responsibility: Daily oversight of financial operations

Typically reports to (04)

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

Do not report on program managers, such as A/R, A/P or Payroll, etc.

16. Event Manager/Event Coordinator: Senior Level Only

Responsibility: Overall planning and coordination of venue services for assigned events Typically reports to (07)

17. Event Manager/Event Coordinator: Entry Level Only

Responsibility: Overall planning and coordination of venue services for assigned events Typically reports to (07) or (16)

18. Sales Manager/Booking Manager/Sales and Booking Coordinator

Responsibility: Generating and closing daily rentals of the venue. May be responsible for an assigned market, such as regional sales or corporate sales.

Typically reports to (10) or (11), may report to (01), (02) or (03), especially in smaller organizations.

If there are multiple sales managers responsible for this function, record the number of them and provide an average salary.

19. Marketing Manager

Responsibility: Promotion of the venue brand and positioning of the venue in its competitive marketplace.

Typically reports to (10) or (12)

If there are multiple marketing managers responsible for this function, record the number of them and provide an average salary.

20. Sponsorship Manager

Responsibility: Securing and fulfilling sponsorships from business sources, local and national as appropriate.

Typically reports to (05)

21. Operations Manager

Responsibility: Day to day venue operations, may include facility management and/or event support oversight.

Typically reports to (03) or (07).

22. Production Manager

Responsibility: Daily oversight of performance-related logistics for rehearsals and performances, as well as operations and maintenance of production systems and equipment.

Advances upcoming performance events, especially from a technical/production standpoint in a performing arts center.

Typically reports to (02), (03), or (07).

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

23. Technical Director/Manager

Responsibility: Daily oversight of the technical and stage operations for a theatre or performing arts center. Supervises stage department heads during events.

Typically reports to (02), (03), (07), or (22).

24. Production or Stage Department Head

Responsibility: Daily operation of a trade craft (Stage Carpenter, Electrical, Sound, Rigging, etc.)

Typically reports to (22) or (23)

If there are multiple production or stage dept. heads, record the number of them and provide an average salary. Can include Union or non-union house crew persons.

25. Director/Manager of Education/Outreach

Responsibility: Oversight of educational, family and community outreach programs for a venue.

Typically reports to (02), (03), (10) or (I2)

26. Box Office/Ticket Manager

Responsibility: Daily management of ticket sales and ticket sellers

Typically reports to (03), (04), (10) or (12)

If you have more than one of these titles, report on the salary of the most senior title.

27. House Manager/Patron Services Manager/Guest Relations Manager

Responsibility: Supervision of admissions/guest services day-of-event staff, oversight of direct delivery of patron service related amenities and programs, usually during events.

Typically reports to (03), (06) or (07)

28. Chief of Security

Responsibility: Overall oversight of safety and security operations

Typically reports to (03)

29. Assistant Chief of Security/Security Manager

Responsibility: Daily oversight of safety and security operations

Typically reports to (28)

If you have multiple managers responsible for separate related operations (Security, Parking, Safety, etc.), record the number of them and provide an average salary.

30. Chief Engineer/Plant Manager/Facility Manager

Responsibility: Daily management of physical plant operations

Typically reports to (03)

If there are multiple managers responsible for separate related operations (Maintenance, HVAC, Central Plant, Parking, etc.), record the number of them and provide an average salary.

31. Manager of Housekeeping/Janitorial/Conversions

Responsibility: Daily housekeeping and/or setup of function space

Typically reports to (03) or (30)

If there are multiple managers responsible for separate related operations (Housekeeping, Function Space Changeovers, etc.), record the number of them and provide an average salary.

32. Executive Assistant

Responsibility: Provides administrative support at the senior executive level. Is not classified as an Administrative Assistant.

Typically reports to (01) or (02)

If there are multiple Executive Assistants, record the number of them and provide an average salary.

Senior executive salaries have rebounded 8% compared to 2012 at the same time that entry level event managers experienced the same percentage decline (-8%).
